The journal encourages research articles that engage in nuanced discussion of topics, in order to bring together some fine thinking from around the world on social, cultural, economic, and political environments of life and livelihood in South Asia. SAS also encourages submissions that focus on social sector issues, insights from different industry segments, impact of governance on business and bi-lateral trade decisions. The journal debates on issues of national and regional concern, primarily from the perspectives of politics, economics, and international relations, but also draws on insights from the fields of management, culture, history, and media and communication.

Authors are encouraged to submit articles that hold relevance for academicians and practitioners alike, and join the ongoing conversation at SAS on the issues of interest. SAS accepts both conceptual and empirical papers, with quantitative, qualitative, and mixed method approaches. The journal also carries book reviews of recently-published literature that fit with the scope of the journal.
